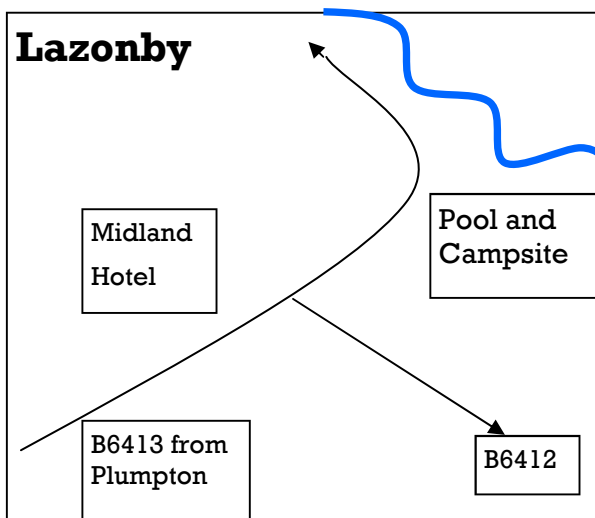
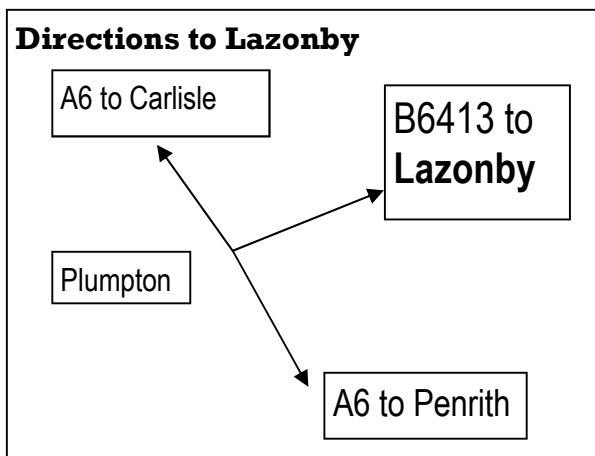


In the local area:

- **For individuals, families, cyclists (close to C2C) and groups such as scouts/guides.**
- **Quiet site by River Eden**
- **Heated outdoor swimming pool and playground nearby**

Our campsite is located by the River Eden, on the edge of Lazonby, next to the outdoor heated swimming pool.

The campsite is open April to end of September. The pool is open April to beginning of September

### BOOKINGS

Bookings can be made at the Midland Hotel, a pub in the centre of the village. Ring 01768 898901 for availability and booking. On arrival check-in is also at the Midland.

### LOCATION

Lazonby is on the B6413, 4 miles from the A6. Travelling north from Penrith

on the A6, turn right at Plumpton.

The campsite is located on the edge of Lazonby by the River Eden at postcode CA10 1BL.

### CAMPSITE FACILITIES

The campsite is part of Lazonby's swimming pool site<sup>2</sup>

Showers (solar powered) and toilets can be found in the pool buildings about 200m from the campsite field. A key is required to access these outside pool opening hours. The path to the toilets is partially lit after dark but you may also wish to bring a torch.

A chemical disposal unit is situated behind the pool buildings.

### POOL FACILITIES

Our swimming pool is outdoors and heated to 26°C. Lifeguards are on duty at all times.

**Day prices** for swimming are:

Adults £3.50

Children (3+) £2.50

Spectators free

Over 60s £2.50

Check our website for opening times.

Children who wish to swim, and who are aged 8 and under, must be accompanied by an adult.

Our **kiosk/café** sells a range of hot and cold drinks, snacks and ice creams.

**Pool parties** are available outside opening times. £45 for one hour including a lifeguard.

**Playground.** Brilliant new children's playground in adjacent park, opened Feb. 2011

### LOCAL FACILITIES

In Lazonby we have:

- A very good Co-op including a newsagent and post office in the centre of the village.
- 1 public house serving food plus 2 more in village over the river.
- A small garage on the main street selling petrol.
- Bells the Baker has a factory and coffee shop open Saturdays 9-12
- Station on the Settle-Carlisle railway
- A Church of England and a Methodist church.
- Fishing on the River Eden - permits obtainable from the post office at the Co-op.
